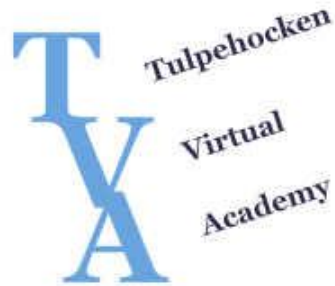


## Advantages of Online Learning:

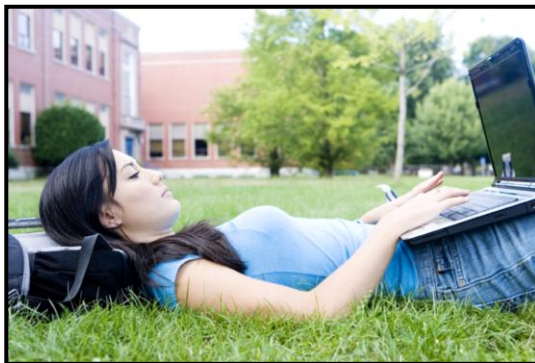
## Is Online Learning for You?
