Through the use of several providers, TVA is able to offer students a wide variety of courses including unique electives. Parents and students can choose courses that meet their student's needs and still comply with graduation requirements to receive a TASD diploma.

TVA students can also choose to work full-time at home on their courses or part-time (hybrid). In grades 7-12, we also offer students the option to work on their online classes in our JSHS library in either a full-time or part-time model. 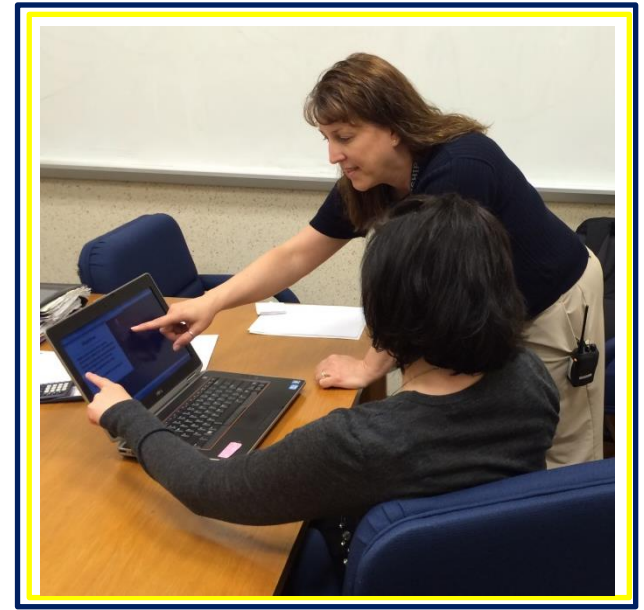

## Tulpehocken Virtual Academy

TVA is the Tulpehocken Area School District's cyber school established in the 2009-2010 school year. We offer full-time, part-time, and hybrid online programs for students in grades K-12.

### Providers >>>

TVA uses several different providers for curriculum. Each provides a unique learning environment for students.

Edgenuity is for grades 7-12 and allows us to use our own T ASD teachers and substitutes. This program uses videos and interactive tools. Edgenuity has mastery based lessons which allows students to have multiple attempts at quizzes, tests, and exams.

Connections Learning is available for grades K-12 and provides live lessons for math and language arts. Students receive any necessary course materials mailed directly to their home.

k12/Fuel Education also is available for students in grades K-12. Using k12 or Aventa courses, students use live sessions and videos for instruction. K12 is the same provider as many PA cyber-charter schools.

### Opportunities >>>

TVA students can participate in any activities that our brick and mortar students are eligible for. Events such as assemblies, music programs, field trips, clubs, dances, and athletics are all options that TVA students can choose from. Graduating seniors receive a T ASD diploma.

### Commitment >>>>

Students must be committed to online learning with motivation and self-discipline. Parents/Guardians should also be aware of the time commitment that comes along with online learning. Online learning can be just as challenging or even more so that traditional methods.
